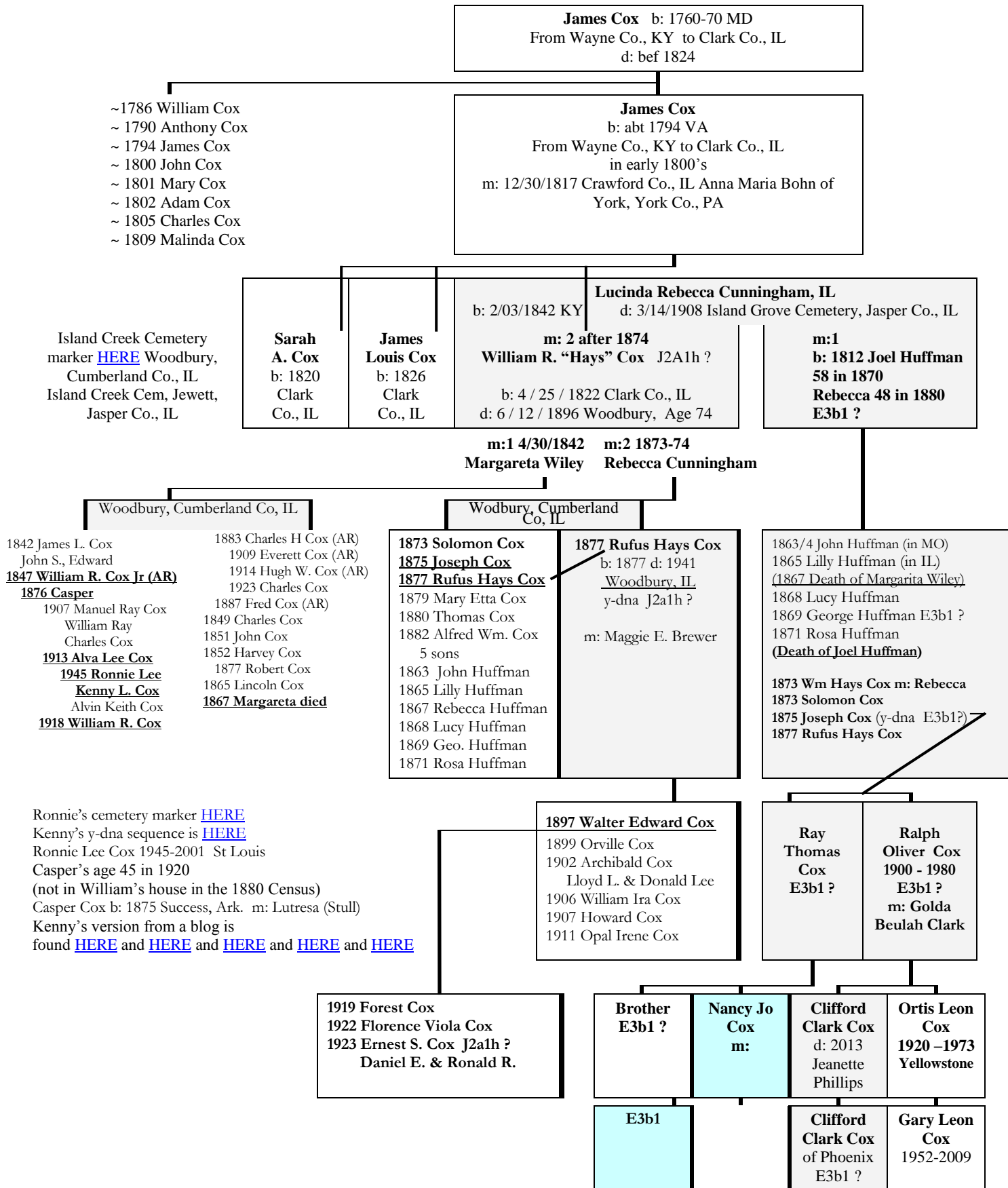

CHART 1b. Y-DNA Matches Among Various Surnames

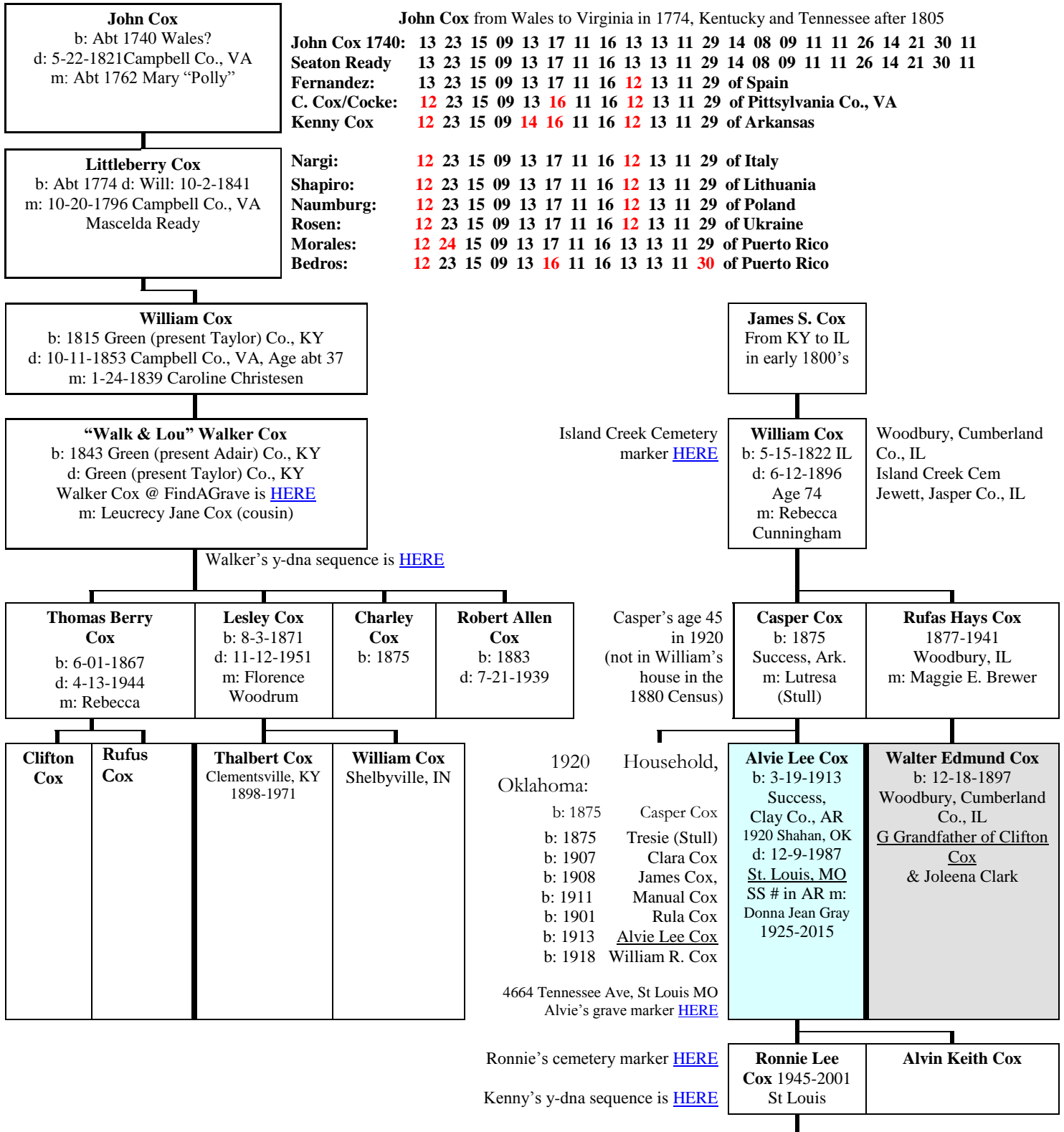

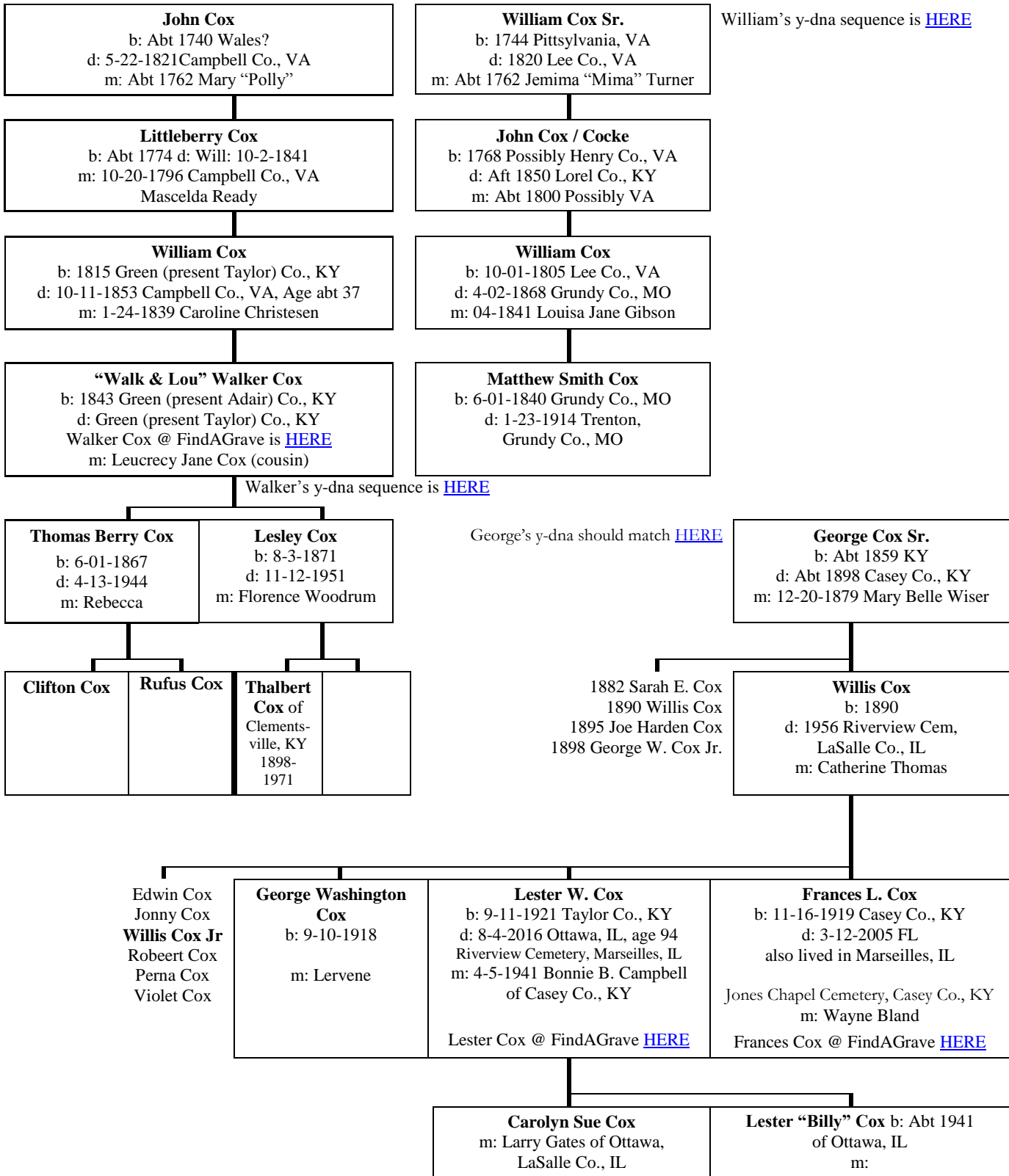


CHART 4. Cox and Cocke Families – Matching y-dna

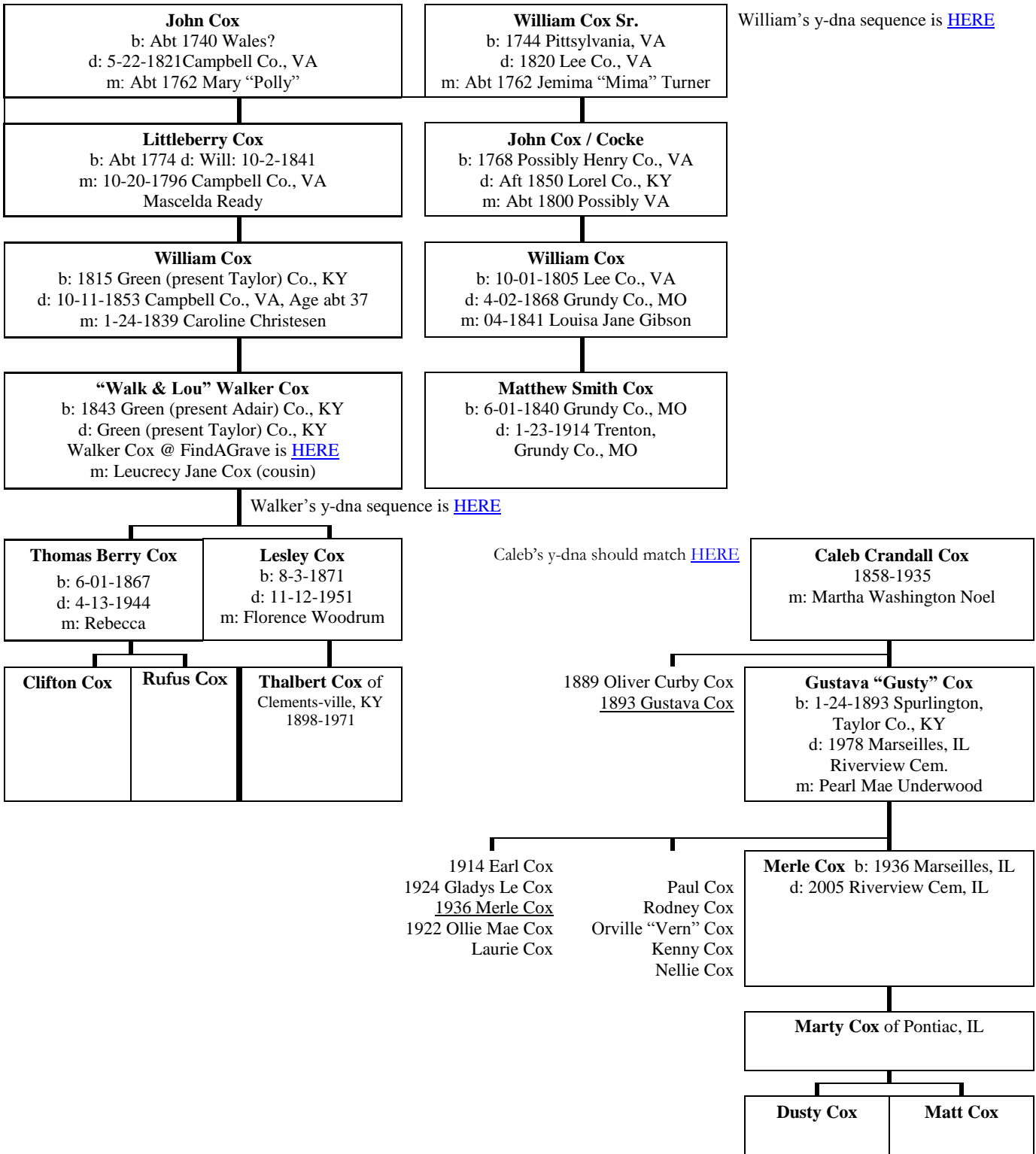

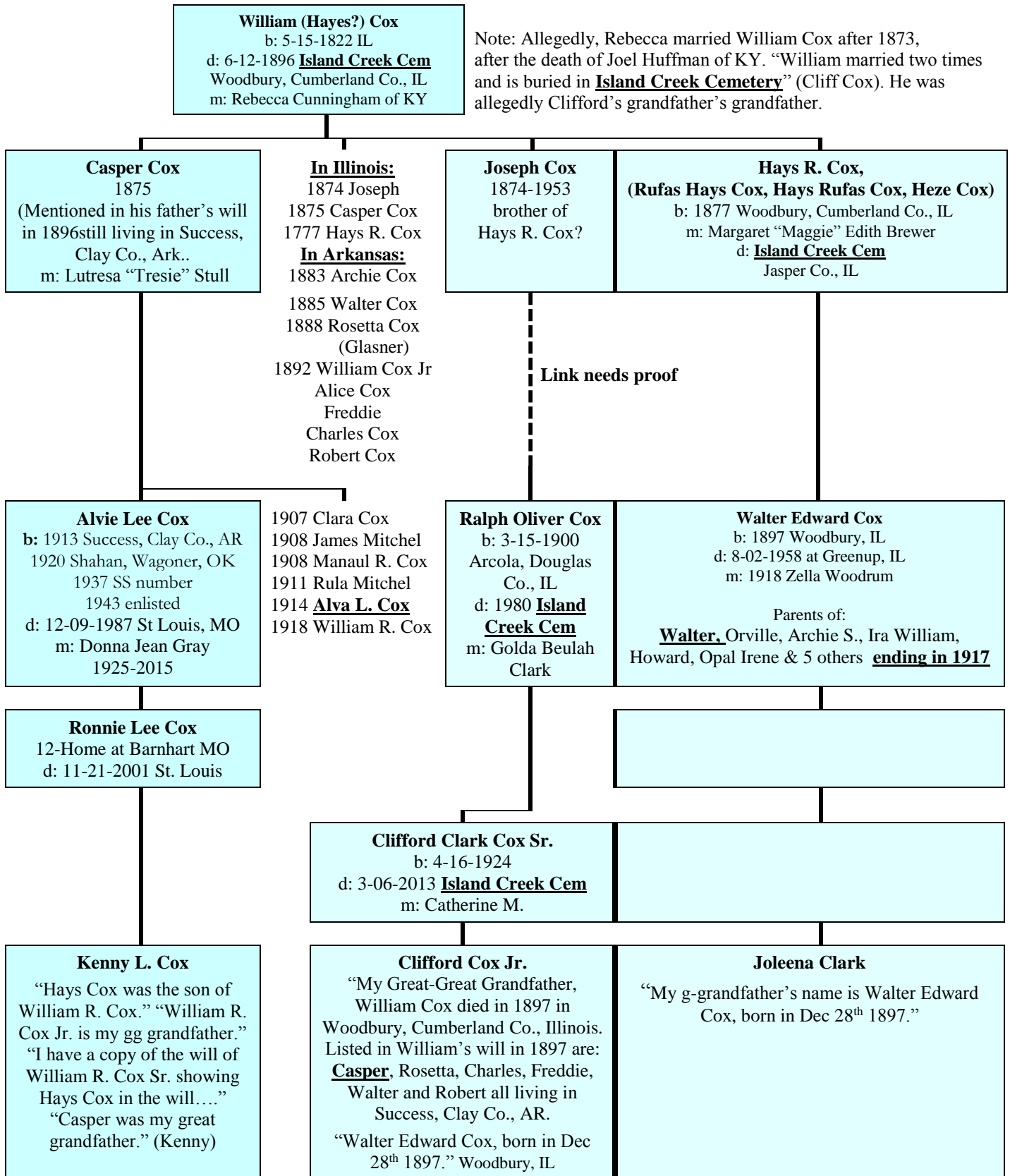

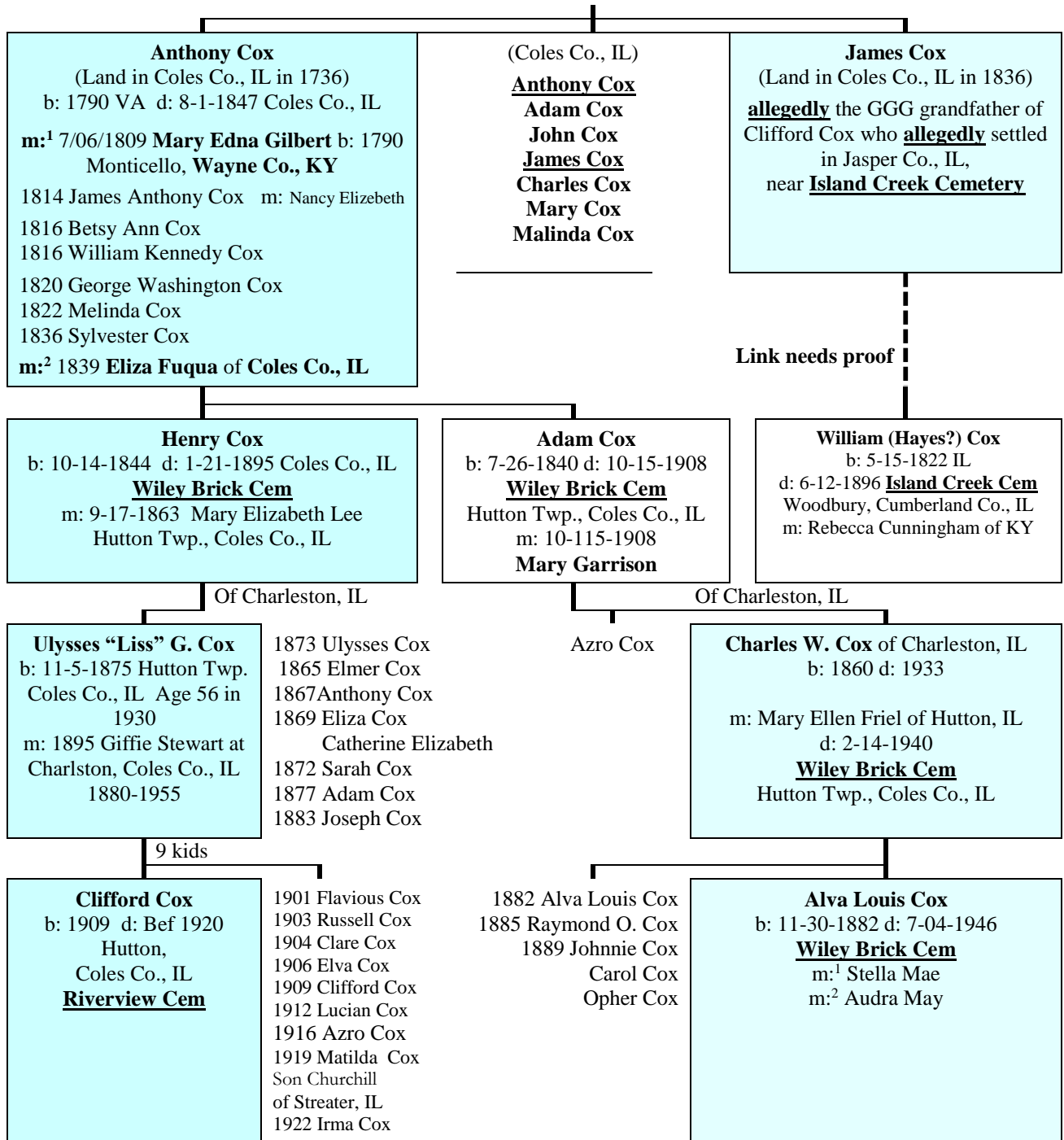
CHART 6. Coxes of Woodbury, Cumberland Co., IL

CHART 7. Coxes of Hutton and Coles Co., IL



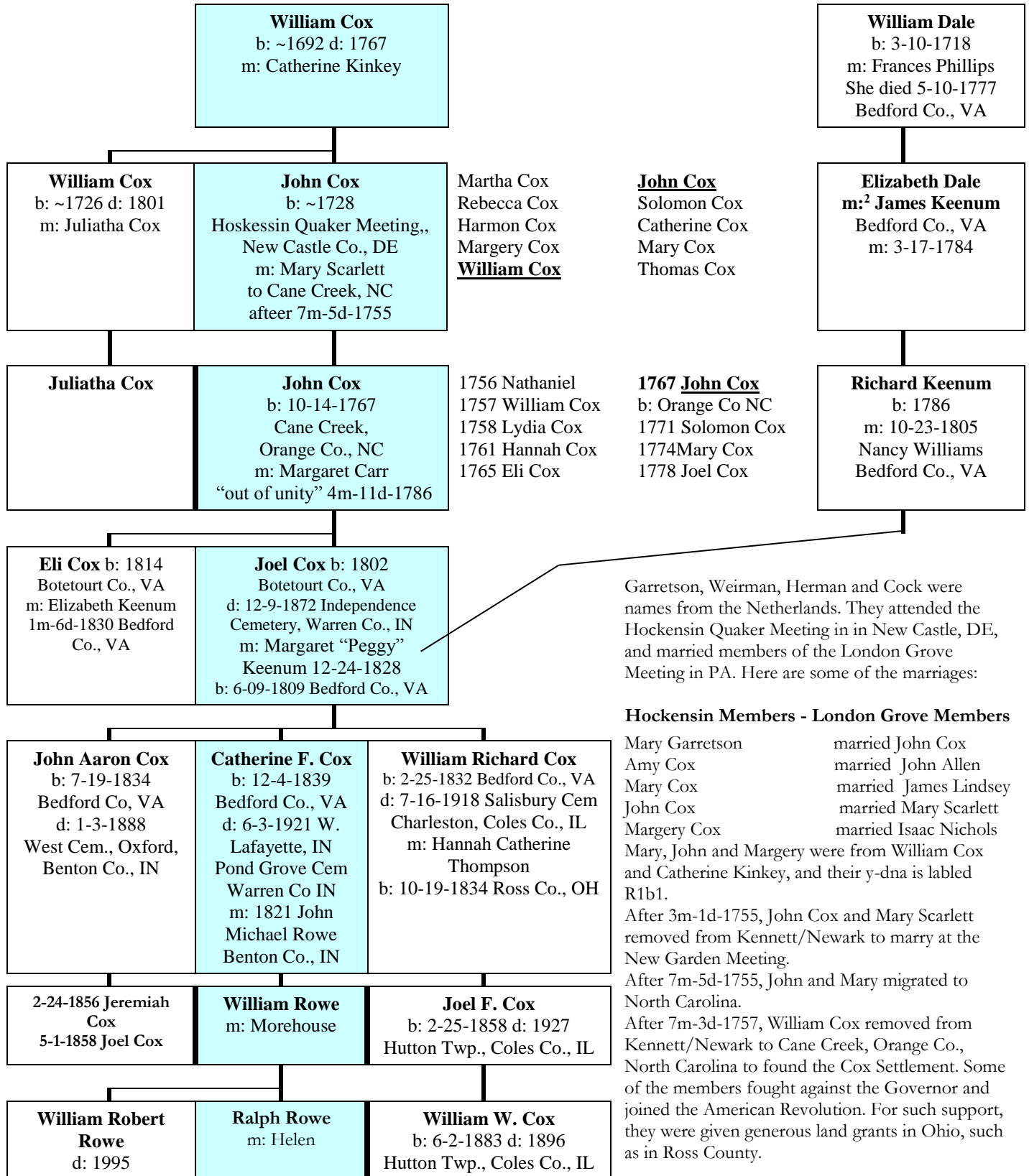

This plat map (two miles wide and two miles long) indicates that James Cox was an early settler in Coles County, IL, not 25 miles away in Jasper County. This James Cox was near **Wiley Brick Cemetery**, not near **Island Creek Cemetery** in Jasper County 25 miles away. Evidence is need to show that James moved from Coles County to Jasper County.

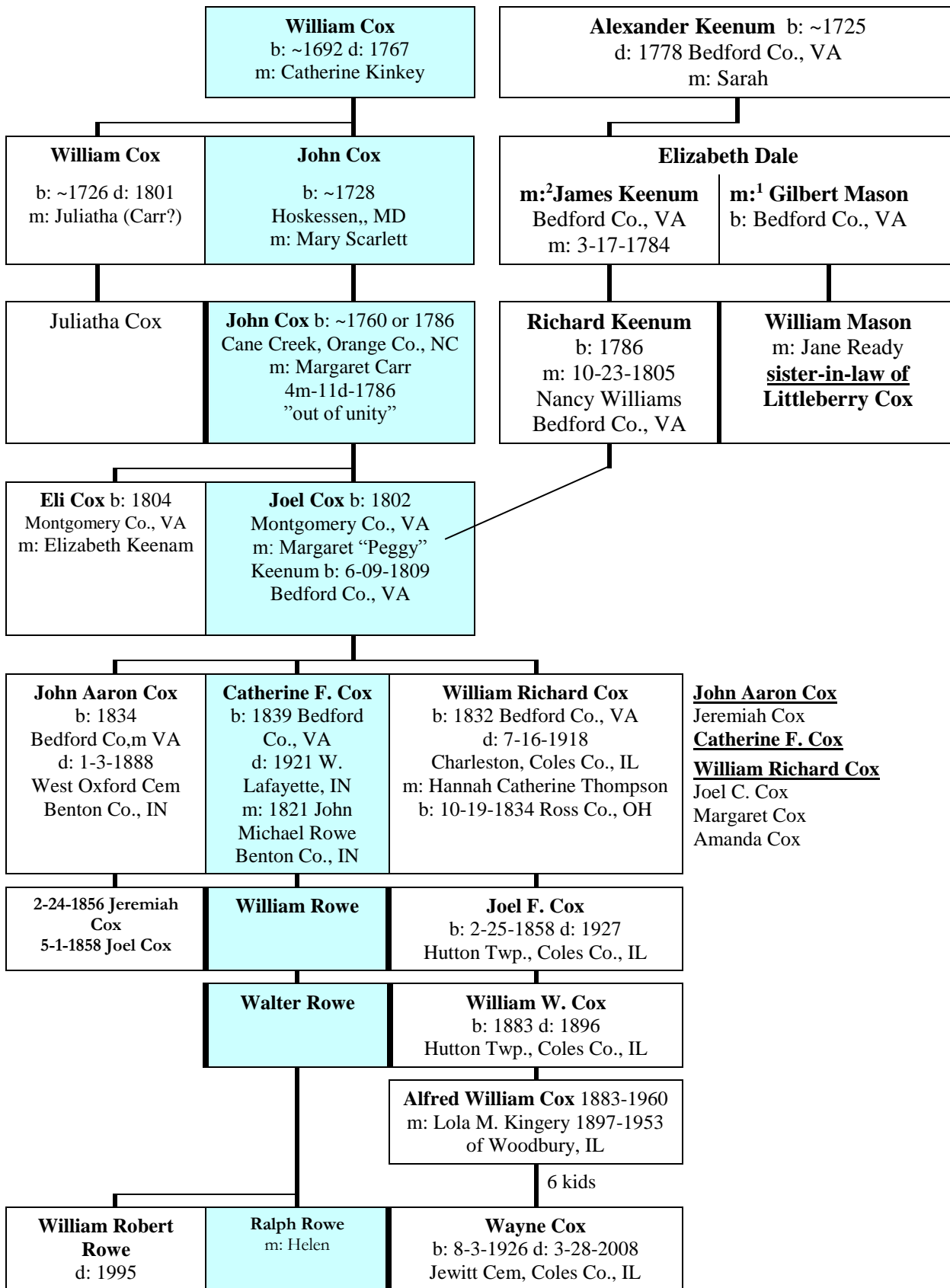

Garretson, Weirman, Herman and Cock were names from the Netherlands. They attended the Hockensin Quaker Meeting in in New Castle, DE, and married members of the London Grove Meeting in PA. Here are some of the marriages:

Hockensin Members - London Grove Members

Mary Garretson married John Cox
Amy Cox married John Allen
Mary Cox married James Lindsey
John Cox married Mary Scarlett
Margery Cox married Isaac Nichols
Mary, John and Margery were from William Cox and Catherine Kinkey, and their y-dna is labled R1b1.
After 3m-1d-1755, John Cox and Mary Scarlett removed from Kennett/Newark to marry at the New Garden Meeting.
After 7m-5d-1755, John and Mary migrated to North Carolina.
After 7m-3d-1757, William Cox removed from Kennett/Newark to Cane Creek, Orange Co., North Carolina to found the Cox Settlement. Some of the members fought against the Governor and joined the American Revolution. For such support, they were given generous land grants in Ohio, such as in Ross County.

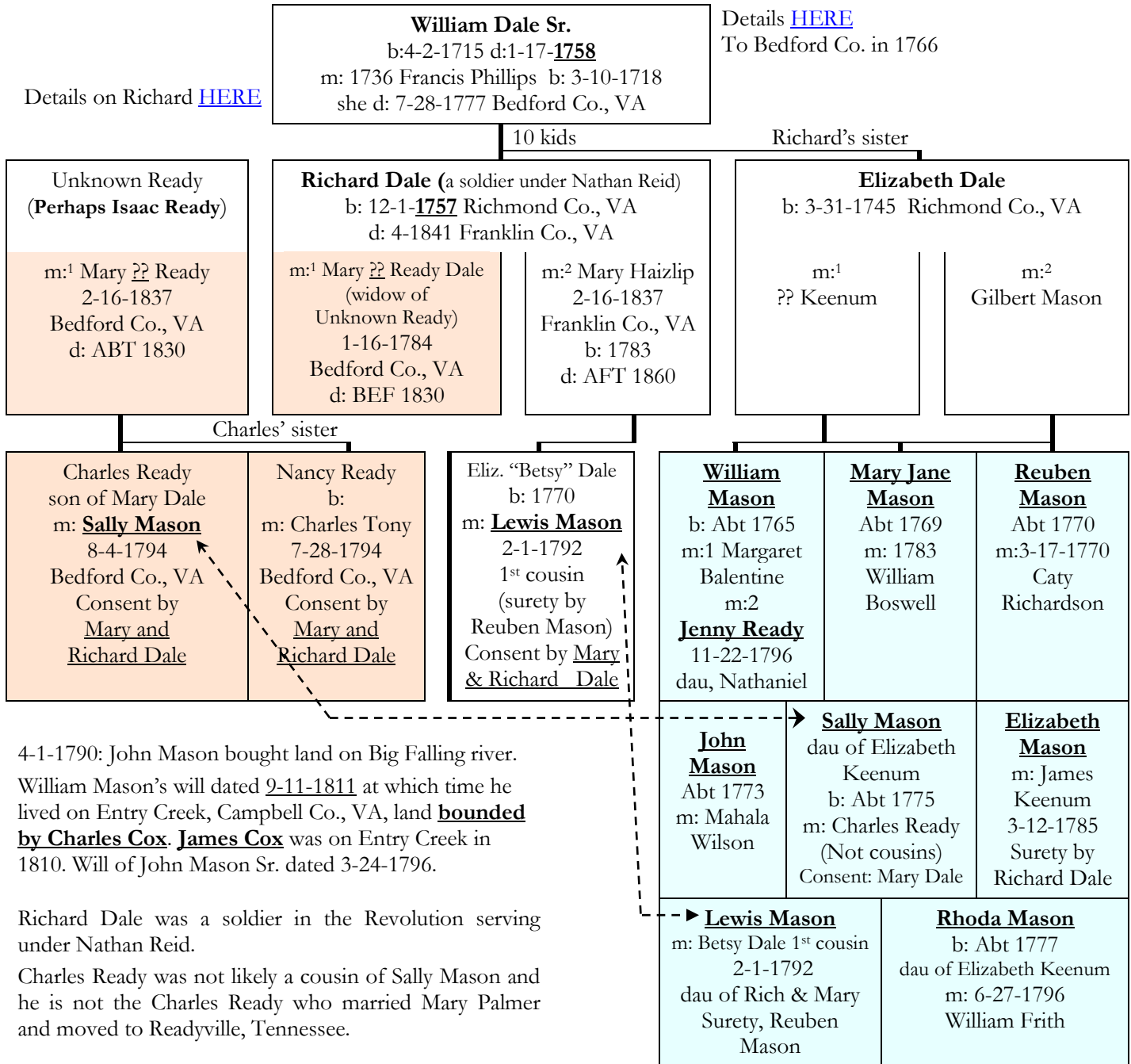
CHART 9. Links Among Joel Cox, Richard Keenum and William Mason

4-1-1790: John Mason bought land on Big Falling river. William Mason's will dated 9-11-1811 at which time he lived on Entry Creek, Campbell Co., VA, land **bounded by Charles Cox. James Cox** was on Entry Creek in 1810. Will of John Mason Sr. dated 3-24-1796.

Richard Dale was a soldier in the Revolution serving under Nathan Reid.

Charles Ready was not likely a cousin of Sally Mason and he is not the Charles Ready who married Mary Palmer and moved to Readyville, Tennessee.

Isaac Ready served in the Revolution under Col. Charles Lynch of Lynchburg, VA. He was wounded at Guilford Court House in North Carolina.

Another Charles Ready may have been a cousin of Jenny Ready (sister of Sally and Massey Ready).

The estate of their father, Nathaniel Ready, was in Charlotte County, next to William Walker, Publius and Erasmus Jones, Sabra Morris and others who had lived at Entry Creek, in Campbell County just a few miles away.

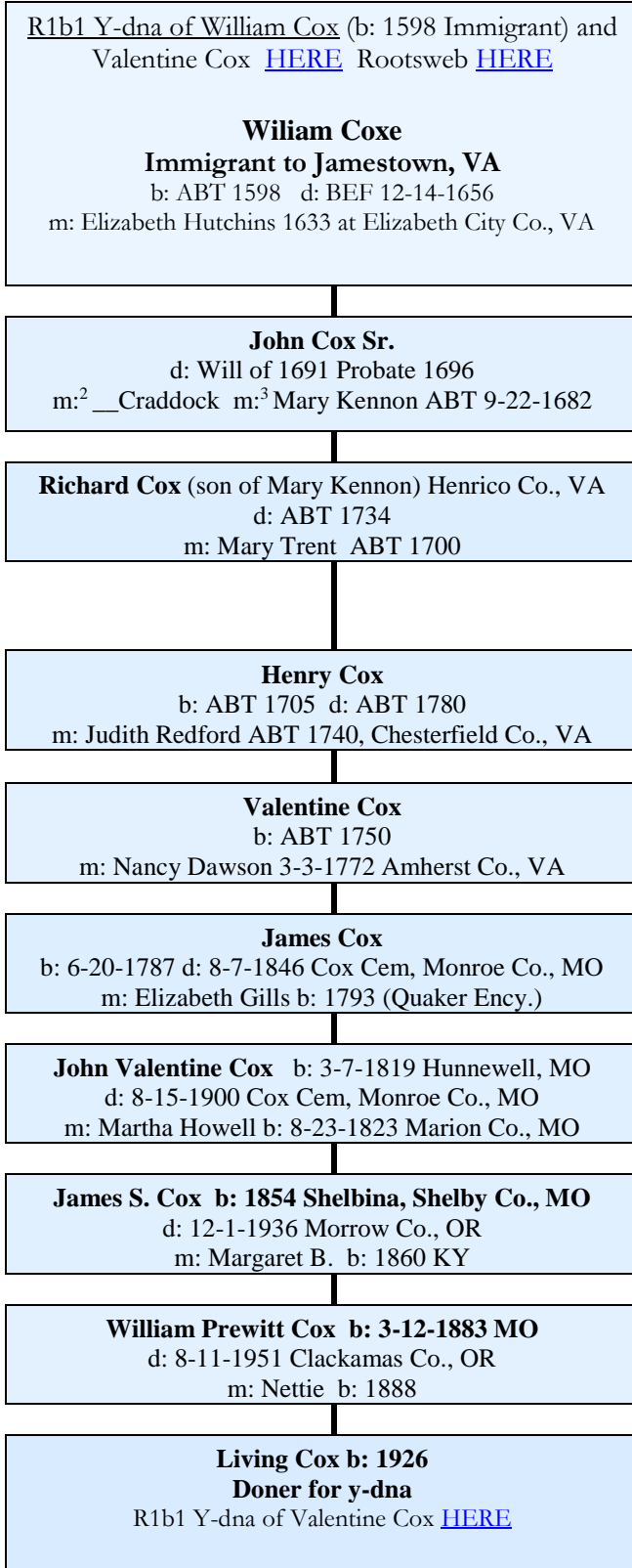

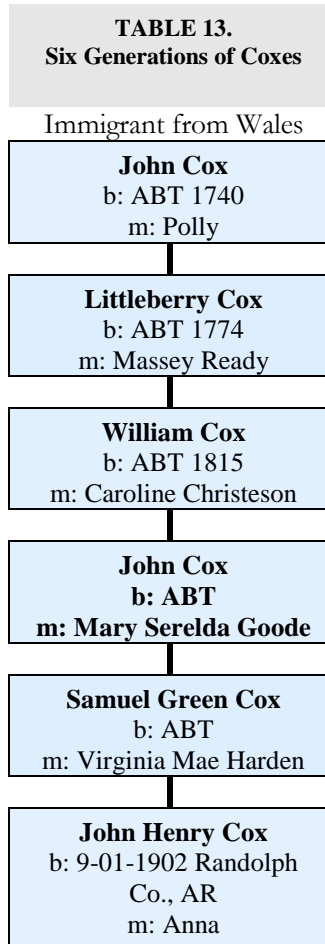

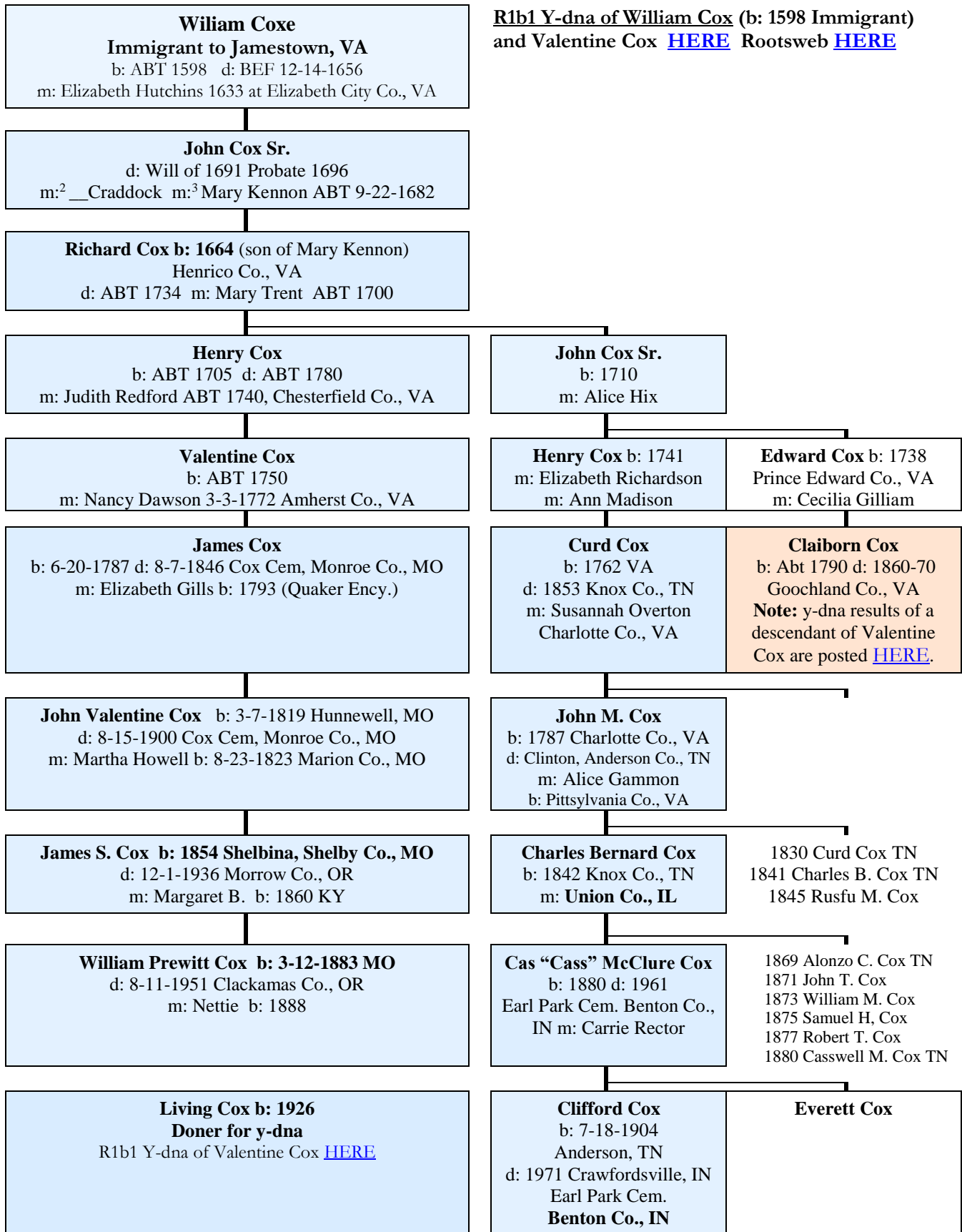

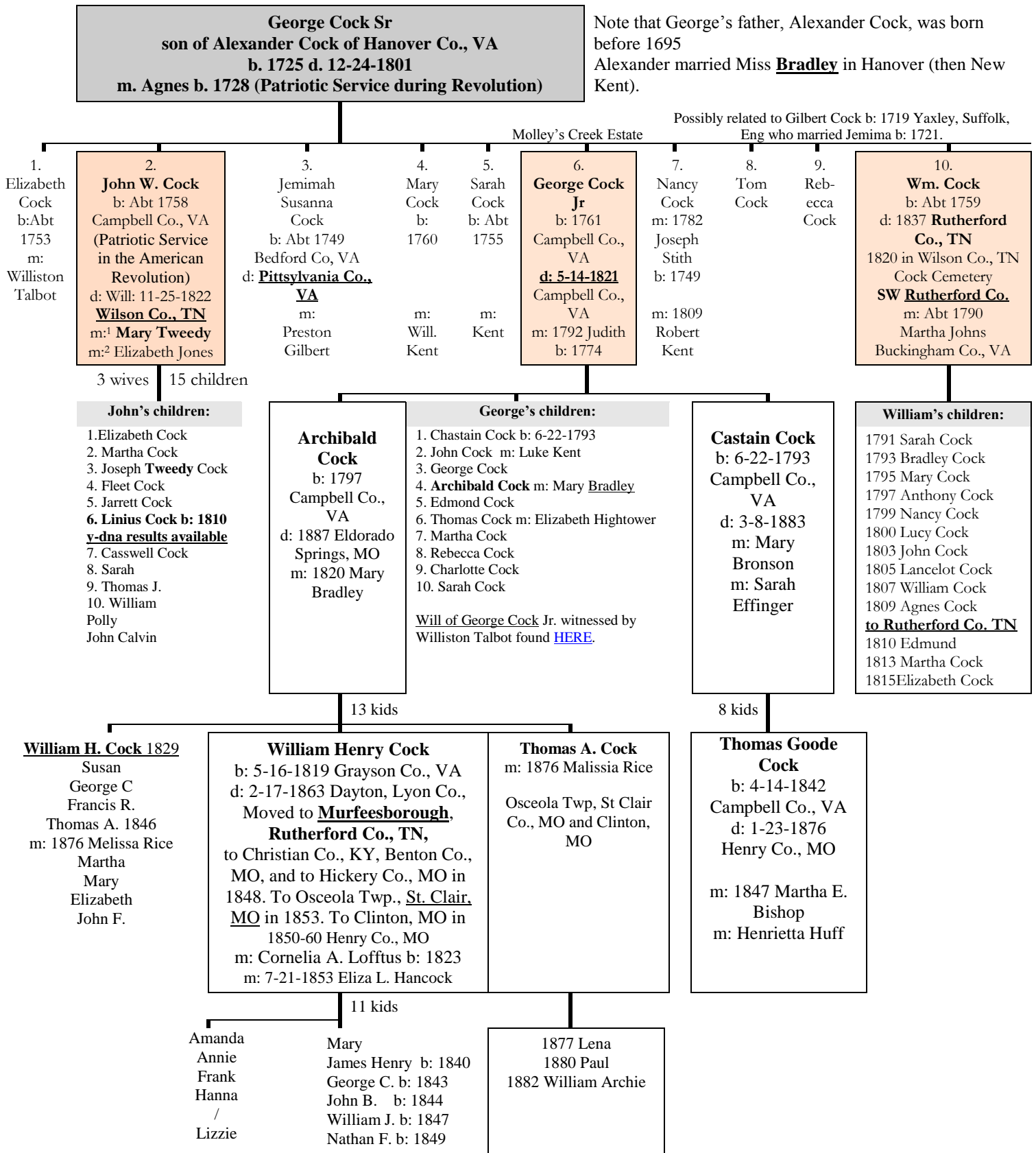

CHART 14. John Cock and Mary Tweedy NOT Parents of Littleberry's Cox



Many have confused John W. Cock born 1758 with Littleberry's father John Cox, born 1740. Why? Mainly because John Cock lived about three miles away on Molley's (alias Briery) Creek, in Campbell County, VA. It was John Cock and his parents, George and Agnes, who did patriotic Service during the Revolution. (*William and Mary College*, Vol. VIII, Series II, 1928, Pp 122, 123.) (*The Virginia Magazine of History and Biology*, Vol. V Pp. 257, 261 and 262.) (Campbell Co. Courthouse Order Book 1, p 29.)

The y-dna of Linius Cock b: 1810 does not match the descendants of Littleberry Cox (ysearch.org). The will of Littleberry's father was dated may 22, 1821.

The following links offer final proof that the George Cock/John Cock family line is not related to Littleberry and James Cox. The two families just happened to live about three miles apart and just happened to contribute supplies for the Revolution at the same time and appeared for reimbursement on the same day after the war. This is merely circumstantial evidence that they knew each other. The y-dna of Linius Cock does not match the y-dna of Littleberry Cox.

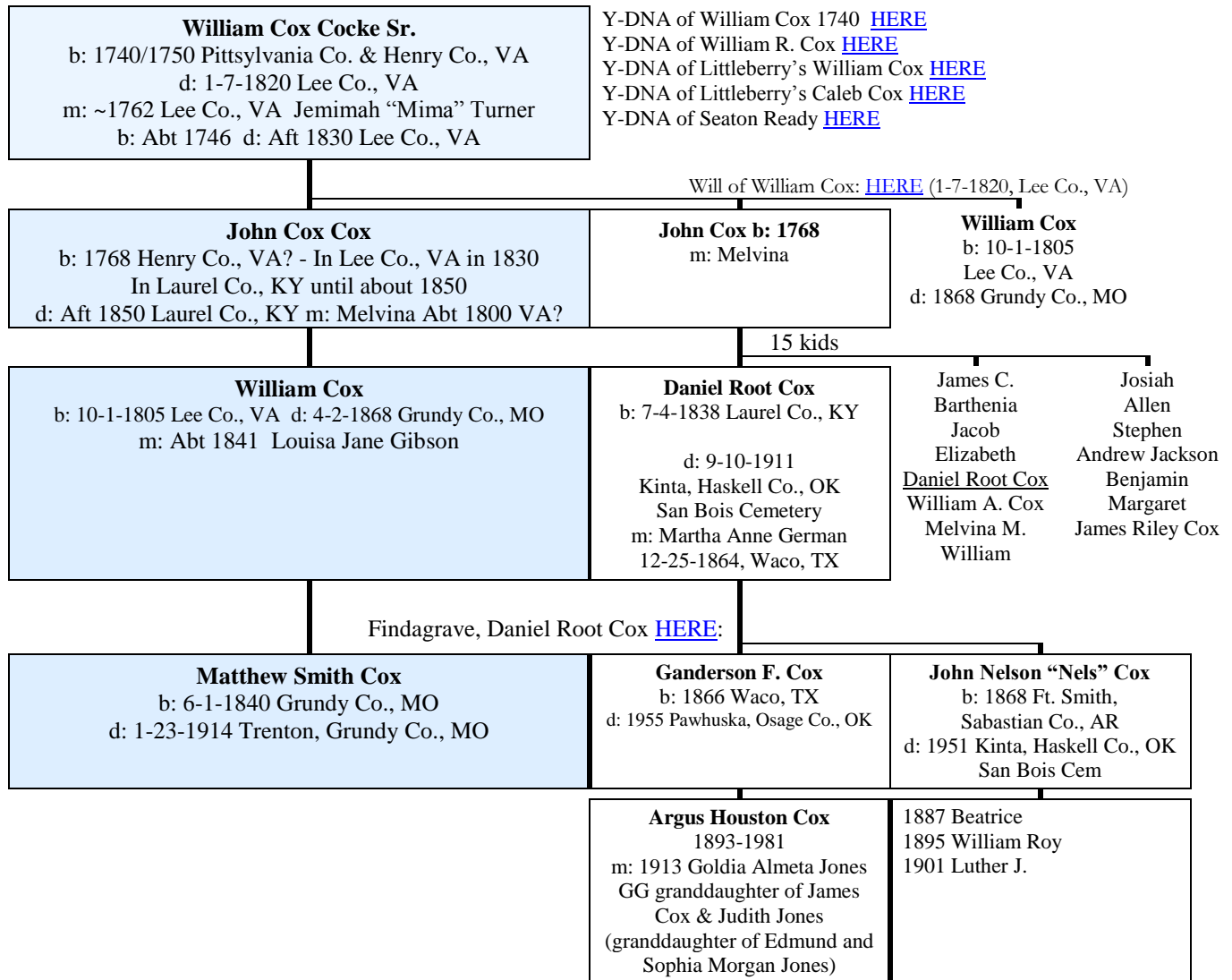
