



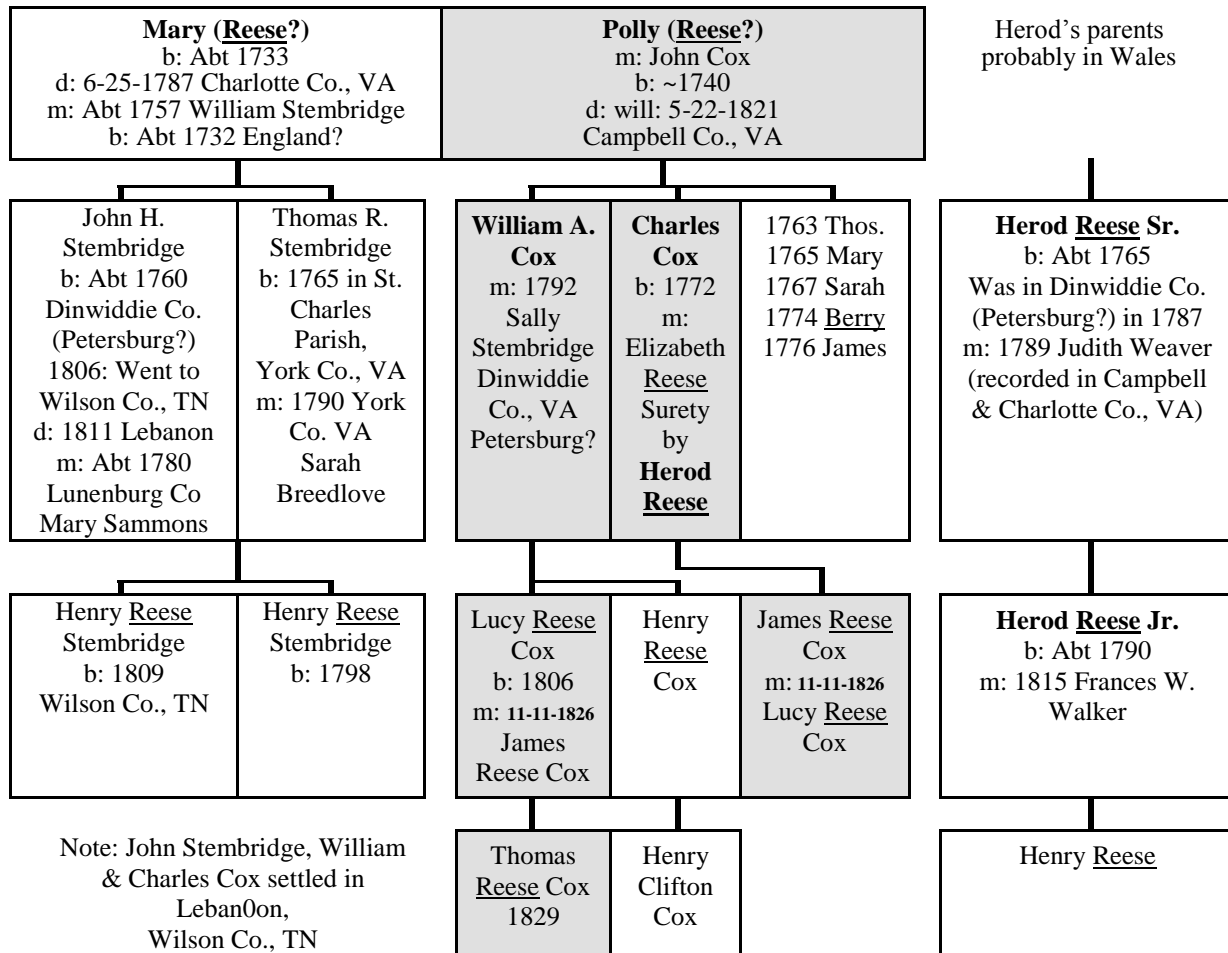

950 Hywel (Howell) Dda (The Good) had a dynasty in Dyfed-Deheubarth

800-1000 Vikings attack Welsh & Saxons.

1039-63 Gruffydd ap Llywelyn in Gwynedd

1066 William the Conqueror of the Normans (Normandy, France) takes England.

1155-97 **Rhys** ap Gruffydd had Deheubarth submitted to Henry II of the Normans.  
1189 Pembroke Castle made into a Norman fortification. Hastings family held it from 1324 to 1389 and held by Jasper Tewdwr (Tudor). Norman King Henry VII born there.
